

# CHEMICAL SPILL OR RELEASE GUIDE 11

- ***Immediately report all spills to CDC at 410-859-7222.***
- Be prepared to provide the following information:
  - ✓ Chemical name (if known)
  - ✓ Quantity spilled
  - ✓ Exact location of the spill
- A list of toxic chemicals is available on the MAA Intranet, Office of Technology, Human Resources, Safety and Training at <http://hq.msdsonline.com>
- For a chemical spill, quickly attempt to determine what was spilled; however, do not come into contact with the substance or inhale fumes.
- Secure and evacuate immediate area.
- Secure/Lock mailrooms and critical infrastructure rooms.
- If you experience eye irritation, burning lungs, or other symptoms of chemical exposure, sound the building fire alarm to notify others to evacuate the building.
- If someone has been splashed with the chemical, immediately flush the contaminated area with water and seek medical assistance if needed.
- BWI Airport Fire Dept, in conjunction with MAA Environmental, will manage the incident and notify off-Airport response units if needed.
- **Building evacuees should remain at a safe distance, up wind, until the Airport Fire or Police declare the building safe to re-enter.**
