



What is an EA?

An EA is a detailed environmental analysis prepared pursuant to the National Environmental Policy Act of 1969, to determine whether a proposed Federal action would significantly affect the environment. There are federal guidelines for the NEPA process requiring public involvement. The EA process flow chart illustrates where the MAA is in the process and what steps remain in the coming months.
