**II. DEFINITIONS**

Modification - Any change to the structural, mechanical, or electrical systems or the physical appearance of a passenger loading bridge. This does not include routine repairs or other changes made by the Maryland Aviation Administration (MAA) or its contractors.

**III. DIRECTIVE STATEMENT**


All modifications to loading bridges can only be undertaken upon written approval of the MAA, Division of Maintenance and, if necessary, the Division of Engineering.

**IV. PROCEDURES**

- A. All requests for modifications to loading bridges will be requested in writing to the MAA, Division of Maintenance, BWI Airport, P. O. Box 8766, BWI Airport, Maryland 21240.

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- B. The MAA, Division of Maintenance will determine whether the modification is necessary or appropriate and respond to the requestor with either approval or with other requirements.
