**TITLE:** Upper/Lower Level Inner Roadway Access at Baltimore/Washington International Thurgood Marshall Airport (BWI Marshall)

## **I. REFERENCES:**

- A. This Directive supersedes MAA Directive 105.2 dated June 18, 1991.
- B. MAA Tenant Directive 301.1 and MAA Tenant Directive 301.2 (Airport ID Badging).

## **II. PURPOSE & APPLICABILITY:**

- A. Vehicular traffic on the Maryland Aviation Administration (Administration)/BWI Marshall upper and lower level inner roadways is prohibited except for Administration-authorized commercial and official vehicles. Commercial vehicles are those vehicles operating under a commercial services or concession contract with the Administration. Official vehicles include: Maryland Transportation Authority Police, Fire and Rescue Department, Maryland Aviation Administration vehicles, and those vehicles expressly authorized by the Administration.
- B. Airport-issued identification badges are required and must be appropriately displayed at all times by operators of any such authorized vehicles referenced above.
