TITLE: AIRPORT ANTI-HIJACK/EMERGENCY ALERT TELEPHONE NETWORK

I. REFERENCE

BWI Airport Emergency Plan 139.325(14)

II. DIRECTIVE STATEMENT

- A. This telephone network system provides a special alert phone ("green phone") at the operations area of each airport tenant listed below, the Maryland Aviation Administration (MAA) Airport Operations Center, Airport Police, and Fire-Rescue Service Dispatch Office.
- B. By use of this system, all network participants can be made aware of the presence of a potential/actual hijacker or threat to the airline/airport.
- C. This telephone network may also be used to disseminate pertinent information from the Airport Operations Center such as bomb threats, severe weather warnings, snow emergencies, etc.

III. OPERATING PROCEDURES

- A. When a hijack attempt is detected or suspected by any one of the airlines, or any other significant event occurs, the alert system can be activated by picking up any one of the alert phones.
- B. All parties LISTEN while the initiator gives an account of the event and actions required, if any.

IV. TESTING

In order to ensure that the system remains operational, and that those tenants having an ANTI-HIJACK telephone remain familiar with its use, the BWI Airport Operations Center will initiate a weekly test on each Wednesday at 1300L (1:00 P.M.)

- A. During the test when polled, respond with the COMPANY NAME.
- B. Any questions about or problems with the system should be reported to the Airport Operations Center at 859-7018. Include the company name and station number located on the telephone when reporting a problem


