TITLE: USE OF HANDCARTS AND OTHER VEHICLES IN THE BWI
TERMINAL BUILDING

I. REFERENCES:


This Directive supersedes BWI Tenant Directive 700.5,
dated February 15, 1995.

II. DIRECTIVE STATEMENT:

- A. Wheeled vehicles including handcarts, hand trucks, wheelchairs and dollies shall not be used within or adjacent to the Baltimore/Washington International Airport (BWI) Terminal by a tenant unless equipped with bumpers or padded surfaces that will prevent damage to walls, parapets, counters, escalators, elevators, or other upright structures.
- B. No wheeled vehicles of any type will be used in the BWI Terminal unless the wheels are constructed of rubber or soft plastic material or covered with some form of padding.
- C. Passengers with wheeled vehicles transiting BWI are exempt from this Directive.

III. PROCEDURES:

All nonconforming equipment shall be removed from active service until pads, bumpers, or acceptable wheels are installed.
