BWI MARSHALL AIRPORT TERMINAL BUILDING DISINFECTION AND SANITIZING

Effective today, the MDOT MAA is implementing a proactive measure to increase the disinfecting and sanitizing of the touch points within the Terminal Building's public areas. The targeted areas are the airline ticket counters, self-check-in kiosks, gate podiums, hold room furniture, tables, and the numerous touch points such as door knobs, arm rests, etc. Target areas are both pre- and post-security.

The cleaning process being used is called the "Clorox Total 360 Disinfection and Sanitizing System" and the company performing the work is "Top Dog Services." The staff of "Top Dog Services" will accomplish their work between the hours of 9:00 p.m. and 4:00 a.m. daily. Although you may see workers wearing PPE equipment during the application of the cleaning process, it is safe for people to be around and is used at various airports throughout the country. In order for the cleaning process to be most effective, tenants are asked to please remove papers and loose items from their counters and podiums each day before cleaning activities begin.
