WINTER RAMP OPERATIONS – SAFETY AND COMPLIANCE

During the Winter months when temperatures are forecasted to be at freezing, or below 32 degrees, please refrain from releasing liquid products onto the ramp surfaces. These substances, including water, can freeze and create an unsafe working environment for personnel and equipment. In addition, all ramp and loading bridge roll up doors should be kept closed when not in use to prevent frozen pipes and for energy conservation.

The release of any chemical substance, such as glycol, etc., must be reported to the Maryland Aviation Administration (MAA). The MAA Environmental Compliance Section, or its representative, needs to review and record this activity.
